## Tripping on Modernist Monuments

The girlscanscan collective was founded in 2O21 within the Student Architecture Studio of the Technical University Budapest. As the architectural heritage of the 20th century is disappearing in Budapest through demolitions, we asked ourselves how the actors—as we call them, the rescue teams—are trying to save this heritage and what is the toolkit they work with.
